

Handicap Matrix for 2026 Spring Tournament

The 2026 Spring Tournament will use the matrix handicap system. Everyone is ranked into a band based on their league position over the last 6 months with appropriate adjustments made by the handicap committee.

A player’s allocated band is shown in the separate list below.

The starting score for a handicap game is worked out by comparing your band with your opponent’s using the matrix below.

As an example, a player ranked in band C playing someone in band G would start with their score on -4 and their opponent on +4 as highlighted.
