

Handicap Matrix for 2015 Spring Tournament

The 2015 Spring Tournament will use the matrix handicap system used for the last two years. Everyone is ranked into a band based on their league position over the last 12 months with appropriate adjustments made by the handicap committee. Band A or B being typically the first team or league 1 squash players and band L being league 11. Since there are not 11 racketball leagues, each player's band has been selected by the handicap committee based on relative league or known performance. An extra Band A+ has been added to allow for players of exceptional ability.

A player's allocated band is shown in the separate list below.

The starting score for a handicap game is worked out by comparing your band with your opponents using the matrix below.

As an example, a player ranked in band C playing someone in band G would start with their score on -4 and their opponent on +4 as highlighted.
